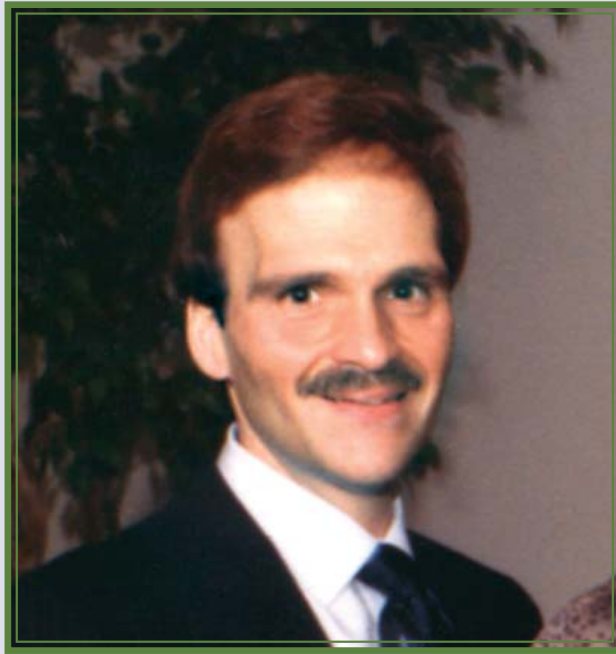

Gregory Mancini was a member of the Long Island Builders Institute for over a decade. As one of the founding partners of the Park Ridge Organization, Greg served on LIBI's Board for many years chairing the Sales and Marketing Council as well as the Education Committee.

After Greg's untimely death in 1993, Park Ridge established a scholarship fund in his memory. With contributions from business relationships, employees and friends, the scholarship fund awarded dozens of scholarships during its short history.

The remaining funds were recently transferred to Long Island Home Builders Care, Inc. (a 501 C3 Corporation). The Scholarship has been renamed and redirected in the hope that it will help to develop and reward children of LIBI members striving to build careers in our industry.

Long Island Home Builders Care, Inc.

Mission:

To provide monetary assistance, regardless of need, to Nassau and Suffolk County High School graduates, or graduates of an accredited two-year college, who will pursue a higher education in the Building Industry.

Building Industry Definition:

For the purpose of this Scholarship Fund, "Building Industry" shall be defined as including the following areas of endeavor:

- New home construction and/or residential renovation
- Commercial construction and/or renovation
- Real estate development
- Finance with a major concentration in the Industry
- Any other related professional field

Applicant Qualifications:

Scholarships shall be available to children or grandchildren of Long Island Builders Institute (LIBI) members, their employees and their employees' children and grandchildren.

Applicants should meet the following qualifications:

- Maintenance of minimum established academic grades
- Community involvement in charitable, social and/or political endeavors
- Prior involvement in the Industry through education and/or employment

Scholarships:

Scholarships shall be awarded to applicants as follows:

- At least one but no more than three scholarships shall be awarded each year.
- The scholarship shall be for a term equal to the original term of study for which the scholarship was awarded.
- An amount of One Thousand Dollars per year (four years of study would equal a \$4,000 award shall be awarded to each recipient.
- Recipients shall be required to re-qualify each year based on minimum standards established by the Committee.
- the monetary awards shall be distributed annually subject to the recipients re qualification in accordance with established standards.
- Monetary awards may be used for elated items or expenses other than direct tuitions.
